Adult Admission Requirements

- Possess a high school diploma, GED, TASC, or their equivalent accepted by WVDE.
- Must be 17 years of age by the first day of school.
- Pass Pre-Entrance Exam (TEAS Test), recommend minimum of 60 composite on TEAS. These exams are given by appointment. Call UTC to register for the exam.
- Registration with 3 references. Transcripts, Interview
- Complete Prerequisite- Medical Terminology
- Obtain physical exam, TB screening, lab studies and vaccinations.
- Complete Criminal Background Check, may be reviewed by State LPN Board.
- Pass Drug Screening.
- Attend Mandatory Orientation Day.

English as a Second Language (ESL) Applicants

Applicants with English as a Second Language Applicants are required to pass the TOEFL Test with a minimum score of 500. Apply at:

Students who do not score at or above 500 will be referred to WVDE's Adult Education Office (800-642-2670) to learn about English Language Acquisition Classes in their area. UTC DOES NOT offer ESL, EEL (English Language Learners), or VESL (Vocational English as a Second Language) classes.

Readmission Policy

Any adult student who officially withdraws from the program can request readmission. Readmission will occur pending space in the new class as long as the student meets the following requirements. In order to be readmitted, adult students MUST:

- Have left the program in good standing.
- Complete an interview with the director, assistant director, and/or program coordinator.
- Pay any outstanding debts to the Center.

Students who drop out of the Practical Nursing Program must meet additional criteria that are stated in the Practical Nursing Student Handbook. After two years from their departure, adult students must complete the entire admission process and restart the program, losing and advanced standing earned previously.
