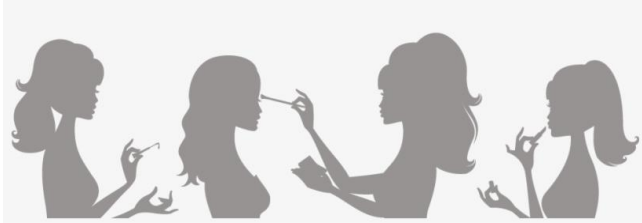


## Overview

Create an exciting career by exploring your opportunities in Cosmetology. Cosmetology is so much more than hair. You will receive knowledge and training in skin care, hair styling, and nail design. There will be theoretical and practical classes on haircoloring, chemical texture, hair shaping and styling, as well as spa services. Students will gain the knowledge necessary to be a successful cosmetologist or operate their own business. Additionally, you will learn practices to enhance your own beauty while developing communication skills to help you be successful.



## Opportunities In The Field

Cosmetology is a profession where beauty is continuously evolving. This creates an increased demand for creative and skilled individuals in the beauty industry. Licensed Cosmetologists have the opportunity to advance their career in many different positions. Possibilities include: stylist; instructor; platform, nail, and makeup artists; salon owner; lash technicians; and so much more.

## Course Length – 1800 Hours

### Option 1: Post-Secondary (Adult)

- 18 Month Program

### Option 2: Secondary (High School)

- Students will apply prior to Junior year.
- Attend Junior & Senior year FREE of charge.
- Return as an adult student with required financial responsibility.

## Adult Admission Requirements

- Possess a high school diploma, GED, TASC, or equivalent accepted by the WVDE.
- Pass a Pre-Entrance Exam (TABE Test). These exams are given by appointment.
- Complete an in-person interview.

### **Upon acceptance into the program the following will be required:**

- Mandatory orientation where the following documents will be submitted:
  - Government issued photo ID
  - Social Security Card
  - Certificate of Health
  - Pass Drug Screening
  - Criminal Background Check
  - 2 Passport size photo
